New York has recently received a major federal investment from the Department of Energy's SunShot Initiative, which will establish the U.S. Photovoltaic Manufacturing Consortium at the University at Albany's College of Nanoscale Science and Engineering. This initiative, which has drawn interest from over 100 companies and organizations, aims to reduce the cost of solar by 75% to \$1 per watt by 2020.

How will New York manage the import of renewable energy on the grid? And what are the barriers to additional deployment of utility-scale solar energy systems in the State?
